1. Who was your favourite character?
2. Were you immediately engaged or did it take you a while to get into the story?
3. Could you relate to Alex? Did the author enable you to see through her eyes?
4. What did you think the main theme of the story was?
5. Did the setting feel vivid and did it play a part in your involvement in the novel?
6. Does the writing suggest adequately how persuasive Theo can be and how Alex might fall under his spell?
7. The author wrote the book having watched someone close to her die in middle age and the effect it had on his widow. The story partly tried to convey the vulnerability of someone who is grieving. Did you think that was achieved?
8. Did Alex's development as a character feel believable as the book progressed?
9. One reader told the author, in relation to Erica, that she must have met his sister. Did any of the characters remind you of anyone you know?
10. Did the ending leave you feeling satisfied or did you want to know more?
11. Did the title fit the story?
12. Did you read any reviews [prior to reading the book and would you agree with them?
13. Is it a book you would consider reading again?
