6. Did the back story of Terri's childhood explain her behaviour and her desperation to find out more about Josephine?
7. Was the setting described well enough to make you imagine yourself there?
8. Did the setting contribute to the story? Could you imagine it having been set somewhere else?
9. Did the details of the exhibition and paintings inform the story or help to create atmosphere?
10. Were there any characters you loved to hate?
11. The story discusses the importance of family both as a nurturing influence and on our ongoing lives. Did those themes come across?
12. Did the ending leave you feeling satisfied or did feel there were still loose ends?
13. Did the title fit the story?
14. Did you read any reviews prior to reading the book? Would you agree with them?
15. Is it a book you would consider reading again at some time?
